E. Michael Jones is the editor of Culture Wars magazine and the author of 11 books, most recently *The Slaughter of Cities: Urban Renewal as Ethnic Cleansing*, as well as hundreds of articles. He received his Ph.D. in American literature from Temple University in 1979. His dissertation was subsequently published as *The Angel and the Machine: Nathaniel Hawthorne's Rational Psychology*. He has taught in both Germany and the United States from fifth grade to the university level. In addition to his writing and editing, Dr.

Jones is a frequent lecturer, to civic, corporate and academic groups on the interface between morals and culture. His talk at Harvard University in the Spring of 1992 on how the civil rights movement destroyed the black family was one of the most controversial of that academic year. In the fall of 2003 he gave a series of lectures in Kenya on African AIDS. In the fall of 2007, he gave a series of three lectures on the roots of European Identity at the Trialogos Conference In Tallinn, Estonia. Er ist Autor von 11 Buecher und ueber 200 Artikeln. Sein neustes Buch, *The Slaughter of Cities: Urban Renewal as Ethnic Cleansing*, wurde von St. Augustine's Press 2005 herausgebracht. Dr. Jones erwarb sein Doktorat in Amerikanistik von Temple Univesity in 1979. Er schrieb seine Habilitationsschrift ueber Nathaniel Hawthorne, spaeter als *The Angel and the Machine: Hawthorne's Rational Psychology* herausgegeben. Dr. Jones hat in Deutschland und Amerika unterrichtet: in Deutschland als Englischlehrer im Gymnasium Haus Aspel 1973-76 und bei St. Mary's College als Assistenzprofessor 1979-1981. Er haelt haeufig Vortraege ueber kulturelle Angelegenheiten, z.B., ueber die Civil Rights Bewegung, Harvard 1992, und ueber African AIDS in Kenya, 2003.
